

## How to find quality information for your research paper:

### You may NOT use:

- Google
- Wikipedia
- Any other unscholarly website

### You SHOULD and MUST use:

- Library Catalog
- CQ Researcher
- EBSCO
- Encyclopedia Britannica

### How do I get there?

#### To access EBSCO, CQ Researcher, and **from school**:

- Go to the Jacobs library resource page
- <http://www.d300.org/web/schoolsites/hdjacobshs/library.html>
- Go to the blue "Resource box" on the right-hand side OR scroll down for a link for the CQ Researcher, EBSCO, and Encyclopedia Britannica
- Click "Library Catalog – Click here to find books and other library material!" for the library catalog

#### To access EBSCO **from home**:

- Go to <http://portal.kaneroe.org/index.cfm>
- If you haven't already done so, register as a new user.
- If you have already registered, sign on.
- Once logged on, use the tabs on the right-hand column to access EBSCO K-12 RESOURCES
- NOTE: There are many other resources available to you (such as Encyclopedia Britannica) at this portal

#### To access CQ RESEARCHER **from home**:

- Go to <http://www.d300.org/web/schoolsites/hdjacobshs.html>
- Go to "Library Resources" in the left column.
- Click on "CQ Researcher" in the right blue box.
- Username: **jacobs** Password: **jacobshs**
