**Directions for your  
Works Cited Page:**

1. See example above.
2. You must have at least eight sources listed.
3. Each source MUST be used in your paper.
4. Arrange in alphabetical order by author's last name. (If there is no author, alphabetize by the first word in the title.)
5. Single space each entry but double space between sources.
6. Do NOT number your sources.
7. Indent the second line of any source.
8. Follow the format of your approved bibliography cards.
9. Your Works Cited Page should look similar to the example
